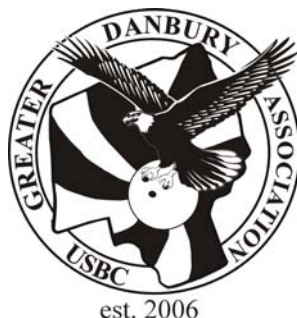
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# Adult/Youth Tournament Rules

1. **Tournament is open to all sanctioned members of the Greater Danbury USBC Youth** and their qualifying adult partner. Adult non-members may qualify for entry by purchasing an associate membership for \$21.00 or a single tournament participation fee of \$5.00 as outlined in **USBC rule 300c-2**. Those choosing to enter under participation fee are not eligible for USBC awards. Only entrants who are USBC members before participation in the tournament are eligible for USBC awards.
2. Format – all bowlers will bowl 3 games.
3. Guaranteed entries shall close no later than midnight March 13, 2010. Entries postmarked the first business day following March 13, 2010 will be accepted. All mailed entries *that meet these dates* are guaranteed.
4. Walk-ins welcome up to ½ hour before each squad time based on availability.
5. Handicap will be 100% of 230 for adults and 100% of 230 for youth.
6. The YOUTH'S handicap will be based on the following criteria:
  - a. Current league average with a minimum of 9 games as of March 13, 2010.
  - b. If no current average is available, the bowler will use their 2008-09 book average.
  - c. If no book average is available, the bowler will use their 2008 summer final average of 21 or more games. League final standings sheet must accompany the bowler.
  - d. If none of the above applies, the bowler will use their highest league average as of date bowled up to and including March 20, 2010, if necessary, based on a minimum of nine games.
  - e. If there is no established average as of this date the bowler must bowl scratch.
7. The ADULT'S handicap will be based on the following criteria:
  - a. All entrants shall use their highest USBC 2008-09 book average. Entrants with no previous winter average shall use their highest 2009 USBC summer league sanctioned average based on 21 or more games at the time of bowling. If a bowler has no 2008-09 winter average or a 2008 summer average but currently has a sanctioned league average of 21 or more games they will use their current average as of March 13, 2010. Standing sheet from league must be presented at time of check-in
  - b. If none of the above applies, the female bowler will be assigned a 165 average and the male bowler 170 average. (**USBC Rule 319b**)
  - c. Average adjustments for entry (**USBC Rule 319e**) 15 pin rule. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual.
8. All prize fees collected in this event will be returned 100 percent to the Youth participants in the form of trophies and scholarships (**USBC Rule 308**). Trophies will be awarded on the basis of at least one trophy for every 10 entries in each division. In case of a tie, duplicate trophies will be awarded. A first place tie will have co-champions.
9. In accordance with **USBC Rule 329**, any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to a responsible tournament or local association official or to Bowling Headquarters within 72 hours. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament director within 24 hours.
10. The youth member's AVERAGE determines the division.
  - a. Divisions will be:
    - i. Average 114 and under
    - ii. Average 115 – 134
    - iii. Average 135-155
    - iv. Average 156 and up
11. Multiple entries will be permitted; however, you may only receive one trophy with the same partner.
12. If a division has **three or less** entries that division will be combined with the next higher division.
13. For Grades 9 & over they would be combined with the next lower division.
14. Scholarships will be awarded. One Scholarship will be awarded to each of the division youth winners. In case of ties, multiple scholarships will be awarded. These scholarships will be awarded at the "Breakfast with the Pro's" on April 18, 2010. Trophies not collected at the breakfast will be awarded during the bowl-a-thon at Brookfield Lanes that same day.
15. Scholarships will be awarded from the fees collected. The remaining funds, if necessary, will be furnished by the GDUSBC scholarship fund.
16. Sport condition bowlers will have their average adjusted in accordance with **USBC Sport League Adjustment** Standard found in **USBC rulebook**. The bowler will use his or her highest average or adjusted average, whichever is higher.
17. All rules not covered will be found in the USBC rule book. **THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE HAS THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE DECISIONS ON ANYTHING NOT COVERED IN THESE RULES.**
18. **GDUSBC YOUTH AND ADULT DRESS CODE WILL BE ENFORCED.**

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# Greater Danbury USBC Dress Code



## PROPER DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL TOURNAMENTS

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire.  
Use good judgment when selecting the proper attire.

Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to:

Hats and or bandanas

T-Shirts (see below), tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops,  
Sleeve less shirts/blouses, etc.

Workout attire, sweat pants, sweat shirts, nylon shorts, nylon pants, short shorts, short skirts,  
short skorts, bib overalls

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**ACCEPTABLE length of SHORTS for men and women AND  
ACCEPTABLE length for SKIRTS AND SKORTS (women only)  
MUST BE BELOW FINGERTIPS WITH ARMS RESTING AT THE SIDE  
NO EXCEPTIONS**

YOUTH may wear the USBC T-Shirts they received when they sanctioned  
Or YOUTH may wear T-Shirts that promote bowling

ALL PANTS MUST be clean and in good condition (no rips or holes)

Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by  
Tournament Management or designee

*If you are unsure if your attire is suitable – please see the Tournament Director – PRIOR to  
check-in to be approved*
