2010-2011 Youth Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is open to youth sanctioned members of the Greater Danbury USBC Association. No participation cards will be issued.
>>> **ALL BOWLERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW NATIONAL ID CARD UPON CHECK-IN** <<<
2. All USBC rules shall govern this tournament.
3. All bowlers will bowl three games in the each event.
4. A bowler desiring to bowl either the singles or doubles event **MUST** enter both. Singles will be bowled first then doubles. When a bowler competes more than once, their first appearance in each event shall count towards all events score. In no case shall the same individual be permitted to place more than once in the prize list for position standing. Participation in singles and doubles shall be unlimited but the bowler may participate only once with the same partner.
5. Blind scores shall not be permitted. **Tardy bowlers will receive a zero for each frame missed.**
6. Entry fee must accompany entry applications. Walk in applications will be accepted. There will be no refund of entry fees after the entry has been processed and squad time assigned.
7. Each bowler will use their highest current league average as of December 4, 2010 based on a minimum of 9 games.
 - If no current average is available then the bowler will use their 2009-2010 book average.
 - If no book average is available the bowler will use their 2010 summer final average of 21 or more games. League final standings sheet must accompany the bowler.
 - If none of the above applies – bowlers shall use their highest current league average as of December 5, 2010 - minimum of 9 games.
 - If there is no established average as of this date the bowler must bowl scratch.
 - **ALL AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED**
8. Each Program Director is to certify entering averages and USBC membership. The certifying Program Director must sign the entry application.
9. The tournament shall be handicapped at 100% of 200 for all Divisions.
10. **Teams and Doubles entries will bowl in the exact order as listed on the entry application.** Eligible substitutes will be permitted only in the same line up position.
11. **ALL ENTRANTS MUST REPORT AT LEAST 30 MINUTE'S BEFORE ASSIGNED SQUAD TIME.**
12. Trophies will be awarded on the basis of at least one trophy for every 10 entries. There will be only one male and one female Scratch & Handicap award in all events. In case of a tie co-champions will be awarded trophies.

13. All bowlers shall be eligible for any achievement awards not previously earned in the current season. League coaches will be responsible to notify tournament director.
14. Eligible subs shall be permitted. Once substitute bowler has rolled one ball, they must complete the series, except for injury. Once an event has started, no bowler may be replaced, except in case of emergency, which shall be determined by the tournament director.
15. To be eligible for "All Events" the bowler must bowl in each event. The bowler's first Team and first Doubles and first Singles scores will count for "All Events".
16. No bowler is allowed outside the bowler's circle once the tournament has started without official permission. No unauthorized persons will be permitted in the bowler's circle.
17. There shall be **NO SMOKING OR DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR PLAYING OF GAME MACHINES** while tournament is in progress.
18. **NO COACHING** of bowlers is permitted while tournament is in progress. (**By parents or coaches**) (Youth bowlers can help each other.) Only positive encouragement will be permitted.
19. In the event a division does not have enough entries, the tournament director can close said division and move said bowlers into the next higher division, or combine male and female divisions.
20. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director not later than 7 days after the close of the tournament. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament director within 24 hours.
21. Failure to comply shall result in disqualification - subject to a decision by the tournament committee.
22. The tournament director will rule on all matters not herein noted. If the weather is bad, the tournament director will make the decision as to whether the tournament is postponed. Please listen to WICC 600 AM, WLAD 800 AM, WEBE 108FM, or WRKI 95 FM
23. Scholarships will be awarded from the awards fees collected minus trophies and breakfast tickets awarded. Scholarships will be awarded as follows: 1st & 2nd Place All Events – Handicap & Scratch – Male & Female
24. Scholarships amounts will be posted prior to bowling December 4, 2010.
25. All rules not covered above will be found in the USBC rulebook.
26. **ATTIRE:** Members are required to wear suitable attire while participating in the tournament. **See attached Greater Danbury USBC Association YOUTH Dress Code.**
27. Raffle – each individual paid entry will be put into a drawing for a \$50 Pro Shop Gift Certificate

Dear Coach or League Director:
Average Verification Protocol:

1. The bowler will use their highest current league average as of December 4, 2010 based on a minimum of 9 games.
2. If no current average is available, then the bowler will use their 2009-2010 book average.
3. If no current average is available and no book average is available, the bowler will use their 2010 summer final average with more than 21 games.
4. If none of the above applies – bowlers shall use their highest current league average as of December 4, 2010 - minimum of 9 games.
5. If there is no established average as of this date, the bowler must bowl scratch.
6. ALL AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED. EACH YOUTH DIRECTOR SHALL PROVIDE A CURRENT LEAGUE SHEET **DATED** DECEMBER 4, 2010.

Each coach or instructor is to certify averages and USBC membership. The certifying coach must sign the entry application.

PROPER DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL YOUTH TOURNAMENTS

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire.
Use good judgment when selecting the proper attire.

Examples of *prohibited* attire include but are not limited to:

Hats, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops,
sleeveless shirts/blouses, etc.

Workout attire, short shorts, short skirts, short skorts, bib overalls

**ACCEPTABLE length of SHORTS for men and women AND
ACCEPTABLE length for SKIRTS AND SKORTS (women only)
MUST BE BELOW FINGERTIPS WITH ARMS RESTING AT THE SIDE
NO EXCEPTIONS**

T-Shirts that are neat and clean - plain or with a reference to bowling
may be worn by Youth (*under the age of 12*)

Jeans **MUST** be clean and in good condition (no torn or ripped jeans)

Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by
Tournament Management or designee

PRIOR to check-in to be approved***
