## 2012-2013 QUEENS AND PRINCESS' TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All current youth and adult female members of the United States Bowling Congress are eligible to enter. Nonmembers who are not members of another association may enter by purchasing an associate membership for a fee of $\$ 20.00$ (see rule 300c/2). GDUSBC local and CT State USBC dues are waived for this tournament.
2. Female youth bowlers wishing to participate in either the Queens or Princess' tournament will need to obtain signed parental consent prior to the start of competition.
3. Reserved entries closing date is January 18, 2013 - entries received after this date will be considered walk-ins. Walk-in entries are welcome as long as there is space available (Queens: walk-in entry fee is $\$ 55.00$; which includes an additional $\$ 5.00$ late processing fee. - Princess': walk-in entry fee is $\$ 45.00$; which includes a $\$ 5$ late processing fee)
4. Princess' Division shall be conducted on a handicap basis of $100 \%$ of 180 . The Queens Division shall be scratch.
5. All contestants shall report for check-in at 12:00pm, walk-ins, check-in by 11:45 am, are welcome if lanes are available. There shall be no more than 4 bowlers on a lane. Substitutes shall be permitted, however after the series has started, no substitutions can be made. No refunds shall be made. (see USBC Rule 314).
6. AVERAGES: To determine Division - Entrants shall use their highest 2011-2012 winter average. If no 20112012 average, an entrant shall use her highest 2012-2013 current average of 21 games or more as of January 18,2013 . Bowlers must produce verification from their league secretary with current average indicated; Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, see USBC Rule 319a(3). USBC rule 319a(2) 10-pin higher average rule WILL apply. USBC rules 319b, 319d and 319e shall not apply.
7. FORMATS:

QUEENS - 5 games bowled across 10 lanes. After scores are verified we will conduct the Step Ladder finalsTop 3 bowlers by pin fall will be seeded accordingly for the step ladder finals.
PRINCESS' - 4 games bowled across 8 lanes - highest total score plus handicap for 4 games wins.
8. In the event of a tie in the qualifying or step ladder finals, bowlers will bowl a three frame roll off $(8,9, \& 10)$. If still tied at the end of the three frame roll off, a one ball sudden death will determine the winner.
9. TIES - Prize money for tied positions will be equally divided.
10. PRIZE FUND: Shall be returned $100 \%$. Ratio of prizes shall be at least one for each six entries.
11. All prizes awarded to youth bowlers will be deposited into the SMART scholarship account \# 10806
12. ATTIRE: Members are required to wear suitable attire while participating in the tournament.

13. Any infraction of the rules shall be cause for immediate disqualification and removal from the tournament.
14. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make final decisions on any rules not covered, unless an appeal is filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
15. Lane assignments- bowlers will draw for lanes.

The entrants agree that the GDUSBC, its officers and agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee if and when these entrants have been prevented from bowling in the tournament, which may have been brought about by war, national emergencies or causes relating thereto resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Greater Danbury USBC Association.

## PROPER DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL TOURNAMENTS

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the proper attire.

Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to:
T-Shirts*, hats, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, sleeveless shirts/blouses, etc.

Workout attire, athletic attire, short shorts, short skirts, short skorts, bib overalls
ACCEPTABLE length of SHORTS for men and women and ACCEPTABLE length for SKIRTS and SKORTS (women only) MUST BE BELOW FINGERTIPS WITH ARMS RESTING AT THE SIDE NO EXCEPTIONS

* T-Shirts must be neat and clean, plain or with a reference to bowling (only for bowlers UNDER THE AGE OF 12)
*USBC provided bowling T-Shirts may be worn by ALL Youth Sanctioned Bowlers
Jeans MUST be clean and in good condition (no torn or ripped jeans)
Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by
Tournament Director or designee
If you are unsure if your attire is suitable - please see the Tournament Director PRIOR to check-in to be approved
