2012-2013 SCRATCH TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. All entries into this tournament must be made in accordance with United States Bowling Congress rules. This is a scratch singles tournament. Bowlers will bowl five (5) games across ten (10) lanes on a modified house pattern. After scores are verified we will conduct the Step ladder finals The top 4 total pin fall will be seated accordingly for the step ladder finals. In the event of a tie in the qualifying or step ladder finals, bowlers will bowl a one frame roll off (10th frame). If still tied, one ball sudden death to determine winner of that match.
- 2. All current adult/youth members of the United States Bowling Congress are eligible to enter. Non-members who are not members of another association may enter by purchasing an associate membership for a fee of \$20.00 (see rule 300c/2). Local and state dues are waived for non-GDUSBC members.
- 3. A sanctioned <u>youth</u> bowler entitled to any prize money will be awarded a scholarship to be held in the SMART fund (#10806), or mailed directly to the current college/university he/she is enrolled in. A sanctioned <u>youth</u> bowler under the age of 18 must complete a Parental Consent Form prior to participation. No entry money shall be refunded for any reason after prize list is completed. Prize ratio will be at least 1 in 6.
- 4. Lane assignments- Bowlers will draw for lanes.
- 5. Pre-paid check in time is 9:00am. Walk-in check-in time will be 8:45am. Bowlers shall report to the Tournament Director by this time with their USBC membership card to establish eligibility to participate in the tournament.
- 6. A game in which scores are lost (not retrievable) will be re-bowled.
- 7. Prize money for tied positions will be equally divided. The only exception will be first place, where a roll-off per rule #1 will determine the winner.
- 8. Closing date for guaranteed spot is January 19, 2013.
- 9. Walk in entries are welcome as long as there is space available (walk-in entry fee is \$55.00; which includes an additional \$5.00 late processing fee.)
- 10. Prize fund will be returned 100%. Prize money will be presented to the winners within thirty (30) days after the completion of the tournament.
- 11. Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled with a zero being scored for each frame missed.
- 12. Any rules that are not covered by the above shall be governed by USBC rules.
- 13. ATTIRE: Members are required to wear suitable attire while participating in the tournament.

PROPER DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL TOURNAMENTS

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the proper attire.

Examples of *prohibited* attire include but are not limited to:

T-Shirts*, hats, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, sleeveless shirts/blouses, etc.

Workout attire, athletic attire, short shorts, short skirts, short skorts, bib overalls

ACCEPTABLE length of SHORTS for men and women and ACCEPTABLE length for SKIRTS and SKORTS (women only)
MUST BE BELOW FINGERTIPS WITH ARMS RESTING AT THE SIDE
NO EXCEPTIONS

* T-Shirts MUST be neat and clean, plain or with a reference to bowling (only for bowlers UNDER THE AGE OF 12)
*USBC provided bowling T-Shirts may be worn by ALL Youth Sanctioned Bowlers

Jeans MUST be clean and in good condition (no torn or ripped jeans)

Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by Tournament Director or designee
