PROPER DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL TOURNAMENTS

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the proper attire.

Examples of *prohibited* attire include but are not limited to:

T-Shirts*, hats, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, sleeveless shirts/blouses, etc.

Workout attire, athletic attire, short shorts, short skirts, short skorts, bib overalls

ACCEPTABLE length of SHORTS for men and women AND ACCEPTABLE length for SKIRTS AND SKORTS (women only)
MUST BE BELOW FINGERTIPS WITH ARMS RESTING AT THE SIDE NO EXCEPTIONS

* T-Shirts that are neat and clean - plain or with a reference to bowling (UNDER THE AGE OF 12)

*USBC provided bowling T-Shirts may be worn by ALL Youth

Sanctioned Bowlers

Jeans MUST be clean and in good condition (no torn or ripped jeans)

Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by Tournament Management or designee

If you are unsure if your attire is suitable – please see the Tournament Director – PRIOR to check-in to be approved
